From the Pastor

Many have asked what a good commentary for Philippians might be to track along with the sermon series. I think this is a great question! The problem is actually that there are many, many good commentaries. Here are my two choices, however:

1) I ALWAYS go to John Calvin. He is never out of style and most evangelical commentary on the New Testament haven't in basic content improved upon him. But don't be intimidated by an old scholar, or the fact that his name is john Calvin. His commentary is practical and basically brief.

Many new or used editions are available on the internet. There is also a free online commentary at www.ccel.org

2) For a more current selection I suggest David Chapman's commentary. I know him personally because he was a prof of mine at Covenant. What you will get from Chapman is a deep knowledge of the story of Jesus (his research was on ancient trial and crucifixion) and archeology (he is the director of the archeology institute at Covenant Seminary and a leader in the field). Finally, you will get the perspective of a devoted father, husband, and pastor.

3) Some have asked about Bibles. I began equipping my Session in Quincy with the ESV Personal Size Study Bible. It is my go-to. I would highly recommend it.
