SKILLS

- Energetic and passionate about bringing youth to know Christ
- Ability and willingness to engage school and community partners, and be involved in the life of the local community.
- Must be Gospel-centered, adopting the Seven Essentials of the Evangelical Presbyterian Church without exception. In addition, being fluent in the Reformed theological tradition is highly advised.
- Demonstrates a clear calling to serve Christ in the local church, with a passion for Christ and His gospel, a love for student ministry, and a humble spirit, and an evident prayer and devotional life.
- Ability to recruit, train, organize and motivate volunteers for youth ministry.
- Ability to handle moral and theological questions with wisdom and biblical insight with attention to an adolescent development and skill level
- Must have a flexible team approach when working with youth, parents and staff members.

WORKING CONDITIONS

- The Youth Director requires flexible hours, including evenings and weekends. The position is full-time and salaried. The actual number of hours required during any given week are those needed to fulfill the responsibilities of the position. Expectation is that the Youth Director will work on Sundays.

- Session – Spiritual guidance and support

PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Oversee, develop, and implement comprehensive student ministries for students grades 7-12
- Develop and implement a youth ministry strategic plan that supports the mission and vision of the church
- Develop a selection of criteria for volunteer youth leaders
- Raising up youth in their Christian spiritual development by teaching them the value of understanding and implementing the Bible in their lives
- Communicate all activities through email, bulletins, social media, as needed
- Communicate status of youth ministry regularly to the Session and congregation
- Encourage and coordinate outreach opportunities and summer programs for youth
- Connect and serve as a liaison to the local Young Life ministry
- Organize and administrate junior and senior high Sunday school class
- Routinely meet with youth individually or in small groups
